Rollover Policy for Hardrock 2021

The Covid-19 pandemic has resulted in a second consecutive cancellation of Hardrock. Given that the last Hardrock lottery was held in December 2018 (almost two years ago), a partial lottery will be held in December 2020 for the 2021 Hardrock.

Recognizing that selection in the Hardrock lottery for those in the Never category may be a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity, runners who were selected from the Never lottery and the Never lottery wait list will have their entries rolled over to the 2021 Hardrock.

Runners who were selected from the Else and Veteran lotteries and the associated wait lists will not have their entries rolled over to 2021. Rather, they will have their entry fees refunded and new entries for these lotteries will be solicited during the month of November 2020. New lotteries will be held for the Else and Veteran categories in early December 2020 to choose entrants and new wait lists for the 2021 Hardrock.

While the number of Never applicants to Hardrock has quadrupled since the lottery numbers were established in 2013, the current mix of Veteran, Else, and Never entrants has not been updated since 2015. To adjust for this, the 2021 HRH will add 20 additional slots to the Never category. These slots will be filled by runners on the current Never wait list. To minimize the impact on the other categories, 5 fewer entrants will be selected from each of the Veteran and Else pools in the December lottery (reducing the number in these groups to 28 and 62, respectively) and 10 additional entries will be added for a total of 155 selected runners for 2021. To keep the overall number as close to 145 as possible, the first 10 drops from the entrants list for any of the three categories will not be filled. The 11th drop will be filled from the category waitlist as in previous years. We feel that this allocation of slots better balances our goals of giving more runners the opportunity to run Hardrock, while maintaining the "Hardrock Family" atmosphere provided by long-time Hardrockers returning to challenge the course again.

Refund Policy

All runners on the current entry list who were chosen from the Else and Veteran pools will have their entire entry fee refunded.

Any runner on the current entry list who was chosen from the Never pool will be offered a full refund if they withdraw their entry by June 20, 2020. After that time, the usual 50% refund policy applies.

Qualification Policy

Qualifiers that were valid for the 2019 lottery will carry over for the 2021 lottery (Veterans and Elses). This is a one-time extension of our usual qualifying period to account for most of the qualifying races having been cancelled in 2020.

Service Requirement Policy

Entrants and wait listers who have already turned in their Service Requirement Form for either of the cancelled 2019 or 2020 Hardrocks will still have satisfied this requirement for the 2021 run. Entrants and those high on the wait lists after the new lotteries for the 2021 run who have not yet completed their Service Requirement and sent in their form will need to do so by June 19, 2021, to remain entered in the 2021 Hardrock.
